DESCRIPTION

The Sign Language Interpreter is responsible for providing content-specific program interpretation and translation for hearing-impaired refugee and immigrant individuals participating in programs or receiving services from New American Pathways. Availability for occasional evening and monthly Saturday (YWL) workshops. Also seeking availability of ASL interpreters during weekday, business hour appointments, as needed.

The Young Women’s Leadership Program delivers age appropriate education and cultural enrichment programming to refugee high school girls for success through adult mentoring, leadership, academic and healthy lifestyle support.

SKILLS, EXPERIENCE AND COMPETENCIES

Required

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Trained Sign Language Interpreter
- Good verbal and written English communication skills
- Ability to interact with a wide diversity of individuals and be sensitive to all cultures, ethnicities, and religious backgrounds
- Must be professional, reliable and flexible
- Must have valid Georgia driver’s license and reliable transportation
- Submit to criminal background check.

Preferred

- Certification through the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf (RID)
- EIPA 3.5 or higher
- Bachelor's degree
